Section 1 (25%)

好きな場所について英語で話してください。 街やお店、公園、部屋など、どこでも大丈夫です。 (1分以内)



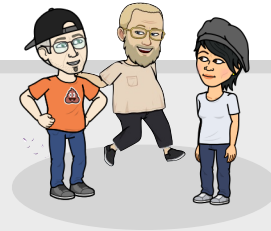

Section 2 (15%)

Read the story below and then introduce yourself (page 4).



John and Yoko visit John's friend, Paul.

John: Hi Paul!

Paul: Hi John. Long time no see.¹ How have you been?

John: Pretty good, thanks. By the way, this is a new friend of mine. Her name's Yoko. Yoko, this is my friend, Paul. Why don't you introduce yourself, Yoko.²

Yoko: Sure. Hi Paul.³ Good to meet you.⁴ I'm Yoko, Yoko Sono.⁵ I'm thirty three.⁶ I'm a *Cancer.⁷ I was born in Sapporo, but I was brought up in Sendai.⁸ I'm a high school teacher.⁹ I came to Australia to see Uluru.

Paul: Cool! I recommend it. It's changes color during sunset. Umm, may I ask you about your hobbies? How do you usually spend your spare time?¹⁰

Yoko: I often go to live concerts and I also enjoy going to karaoke bars in my free time.

Paul: I love music too. I'm crazy about playing the guitar. When did you come to Australia?

Yoko: I arrived about three weeks ago.

Paul: Only three weeks ago? So how long are you going to stay here?

Yoko: Not long . . . I'm going back to Japan the day after tomorrow.

Paul: Really? The day after tomorrow? Why are you going back so soon?

Yoko: Well . . . I have to go back because I want to attend my sister's wedding. I wish I could stay longer, but I guess that's life.¹¹

Paul: Yeah. That's too bad.¹² Anyway, if you come here again, please look me up.¹³

Yoko: Thanks Paul, I'll do that. Bye!

*Cancer = 蟹座

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Long time no see. ¹

"Long time no see" means しばらくですね or 久しぶり。

Why don't you introduce yourself, Yoko. ² (紹介) (= Please introduce yourself)

Self introductions (自己紹介) are very important.

例 "Hi there. Could you please introduce yourself?" or
"Hello, please introduce yourself."

Hi Paul. ³ (挨拶について)

At first, you can say "Hi", "Hi everyone" or "Hello".
(こんにちは = Hi, Hello etc...)

Good to meet you. ⁴ (はじめまして)

"Good to meet you" means 「はじめまして」 in Japanese.

BUT, "How you doing?" can be used in the same way.

例 Simon: "Hi, how you doing? I'm Simon."
(サイモンです。よろしく)

John: "Hello. I'm John. Nice to meet you." ("meet" の代わり、"know" もあり)
(はじめまして。ジョンです。)

"How you doing?" & "Nice to meet you," are also the
same as "How do you do?", but "How do you do?" is more polite. (See text p.7)

I'm Yoko, Yoko Sono. ⁵ (名前について)

Say your name like this: (自分の名前を言うとき),

"Hi, I'm 名前." 例 (Hi, I'm Yoko.)

or "Hello, my name is 名前." 例 (Hello, my name is Yoko.)

You can also use your surname (姓):

"I'm 名前 姓." 例 (I'm Yoko Sono.)

or "My name is 名前 姓." 例 (My name is Yoko Sono.)

This style is friendly:

"I'm 名前、名前 姓." 例 (I'm Yoko, Yoko Sono.)

"Please call me 名前." 例 (Please call me Yoko.)

I'm thirty three. ⁶ (歳について)

**In foreign countries, you DO NOT often ask people their age.

(普通、外国人が人の歳はあまり聞かないこと。自分の歳を言ってもいいけど....)

However, if you talk about your own age, you say

"I'm ... years old." (私は... 歳です。)

or "I'm ..." **("years old" を無くした方がフレンドリーです)

I'm a Cancer. ⁷ (星座について)

Do you know your sign? What sign are you? What sign of the zodiac are you?

何座ですか? I'm a Cancer. (蟹座)

*A lot of foreigners DON'T know their blood type, but DO know their sign.

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I was born in Sapporo, but I was brought up in Sendai.⁸ (出身について)

You can say :

"I'm from . . ." (. . . の出身です。)

or "I was born in . . ." (. . . の生まれです。)

DON'T say:

"I came from . . ." X (. . . から来ました。) (意味は違います。)

"My from is . . ." X (意味がありません。)

If you live in a DIFFERENT place to where you were born,
(住んでいるところと出身が違う場合), you can say;

"I was born in (xxxx), but I live in (yyyy) now / I was brought up in (yyyy)." (xxxxの出身ですが、今は、yyyyに住んでいる / or yyyyの育ち。)

例 "I was born in Osaka, but I live in Kobe now."

I'm an high school teacher.⁹ (仕事について)

If you **have a job**, you can say:

"I'm a . . ." (. . . です。)

"I'm a public servant." (公務員です。)

or "I work for . . ." (. . . に勤めている。)

"I work for Hitachi." (日立に勤めている。)

If you are at **university or college**, you can say something like:

"I'm a . . . college student." (. . . 大学生です。)

"I'm a . . . university student." (. . . 大学生です。)

or "I'm a 2nd year university student." ^A (大学の2年生です。)

"I'm a college sophomore." ^B (大学の2年生です。)

(A = British English, B = US English)

How do you (usually) spend your spare time?¹⁰ (趣味について)

A lot of dictionaries say 趣味 = hobby.

It might be OK, but there are better expressions than:

"What is your hobby?" (もっと良い言い方がある...)

INSTEAD (代わりに)

"How do you spend your spare time?"

or "How do you spend your free time?"

or "What do you like doing in your spare time?"

or "What do you like doing in your free time?" など

In conversational English, you can answer like this:

"I like (動名詞) in my spare time."

or "I like (動名詞) in my free time."

or "I'm interested in (動名詞 or 名詞)."

例 "I like playing baseball in my spare time."

"I like watching movies in my free time."

"I'm interested in surfing the internet." ----> (Don't forget ". . . ing")

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So, **You can introduce yourself like this↓**. (このように自己紹介ができます。)

That's life! ¹¹ (仕様ががない)

"It can't be helped."

"There's nothing we can do about it."

"That's life."

(仕様ががない、等)

"C'est la vie."

"Qué será, será."

Too bad ~ That's too bad. ¹² (残念)

"Too bad!"

is the same as

(残念ですね (一般的・自然))

"That's too bad".

お気の毒に (より深刻・同情の気持ちが強い)

Look me up. ¹³ (立ち寄って／寄って).

"Look me up!" or "Look us up!"

means

"Please come and visit me".

例

"If you come to Sapporo, please look me up while you are here."

(札幌に来たら、ぜひ遊びに来てください。)

OK? So, please introduce yourself here. (15%)
